

Lavish™ Lavenders have been bred in Australia by Paradise [®] Plants and are a breakthrough in Lavender breeding. Regular Lavenders have just a few wings at the top of the flower, whereas Lavish™ Lavenders have highly fragrant, gorgeous wings all the way down the flower head, creating double the impact. The bigger the plants get the more flowers they produce. Bred in Australia for Australian conditions, these compact lavenders are perfect for low hedging or containers as colourful feature plants. Grow in a sunny, well drained position. Feed in spring and summer and prune lightly after flowering to maintain shape. Protect from heavy frost. Drought tolerant once established.

use: low hedges, pots and feature planting
